During this meeting the club had the honor of Hernando County Board Commissioner, Jerry Cambell who provided information on the direction of the Board of County Commissioners. Mr. Campbell provided an overview of the recently organized Delegation on Government Efficiency (DOGE) Committee in Hernando County, like the Federal Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE). The County Committee is an advisory body to promote efficient use of taxpayer funds, and transparency in County government operations and is to provide recommendations to the BOCC .

In addition, Mr. Campbell provided information on the use of the County web site and answered questions on the status of projects of importance to residents. Among the questions were the status of traffic light on County Line Rd at Linden Dr.; widening of Barclay Ave. from Cortez Blvd. and Powell Rd.; and residents' issues with the installation of license plate readers within the county. 




General Membership Meeting
