PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

June 2024

Good News: The NYS Appellate Division issued a unanimous four (4) judge decision affirming the lower court decision "Permanently enjoining the City from eliminating Retirees existing health insurance". This ruling requires the City to continue providing retirees with the traditional Medicare and Supplemental coverage (Senior Care) we obtained during negotiations. This does not mean this issue has been finalized. The city still has options. See e-mail previously sent for additional information.

Do not forget to send a contribution to the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees. This will help with the legal expenses of defending our rights to acceptable negotiated health insurance coverage. 
