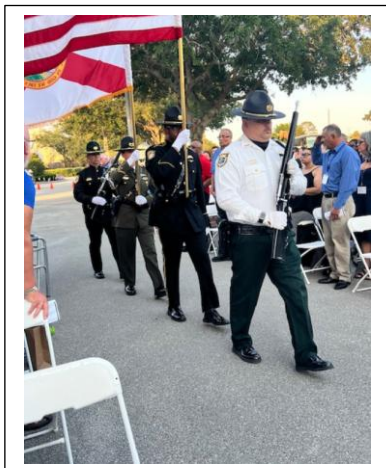

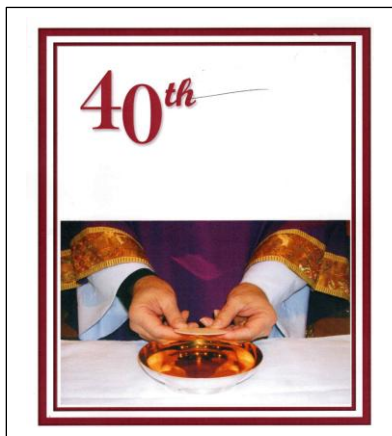
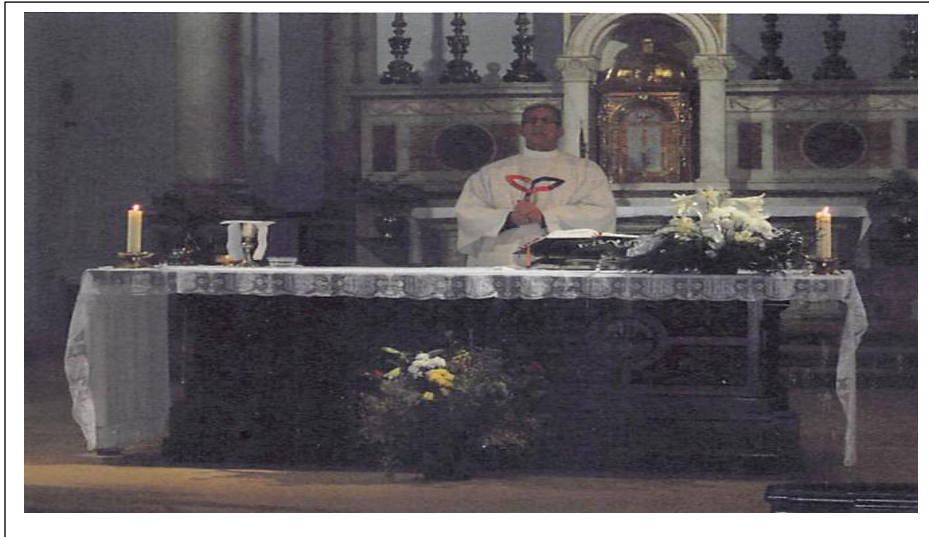


Anniversary Celebration
