In last month's edition of the Hernando 10-13 Newsletter there was an article relating to the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees request for retirees to participate in applying pressure on City Council members in support of Council Intro bill 1096, the retiree health care bill. The New York State Court of Appeals, the highest court in New York State, is currently deliberating whether the city can eliminate all current health coverage options for retirees and implement a Medicare Advantage plan. We should not be placing all our eggs in one basket; by relying on the court to protect our hard-earned medical benefits, we need to continue the pressure on the City Council to implement Intro Bill 1096 to ensure or medical benefits. Do all you can to get this bill passed.

NYC Transit Police Florida Reunion is scheduled for August 3rd - August 7th at the Radisson Resort at Port Canaveral.

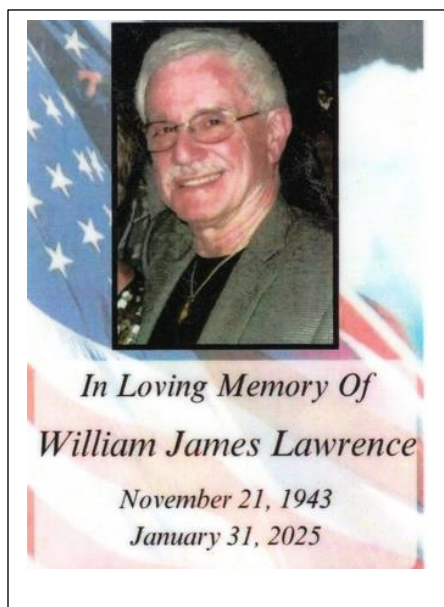


