PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

May 2023

Following the city's notice to implement the Aetna Medicare Advantage Plan (MAP) for all Medicare eligible city retirees nothing appears to be moving forward. This may be due to the city "slow rolling" the process to have the MAP reviewed and approved prior to implementation by the NYC Comptroller. The NYC Comptroller has indicated that they have yet to receive the MAP for review and they have up to thirty days for such review. The city's plan to implement the MAP is for retirees to have a period between (May 1st to June 30th) to pose questions to Aetna regarding the MAP and to decide whether to accept the plan or "opt out."

New York City's Office of Labor Relations has posted on their web site (www.officeoflaborrelations.com) information regarding the proposed city implementation of its Medicare Advantage Plan. This information appears to not be correct as the MAP has yet to be approved. In any case spend some time understanding the options, with the information currently available, so that you may make the appropriate decision for you and your family. We anticipate further discussions at our upcoming meeting and will continue to provide any information we may receive regarding actions of the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees (www.nycretirees.org) in defense of retirees' rights.

We as a club have been invited to attend, with the Suncoast 10-13, the annual Police Memorial Service on May 18th in Clearwater. Information is included later in this newsletter. Please make every effort to attend.

Our next meeting is May 10th. Hope to see you at the upcoming meeting. Come and enjoy some cheer with your brothers and sisters in blue.

All applicants must be entering their first year of college. Applications must be completely filled out to the best of ability, sponsored and notarized. All applications must be submitted and received or postmarked on or before July 15th of the current year

Medicare Part B 2022 Reimbursement

Medicare-eligible retirees and their Medicare-eligible dependents should have received during April the standard amount of Medicare Part B amount of \$170.10 per month (\$170.10 x 12 months = \$2,041.20).

If you already submitted your Medicare Part A & B card to the Health Benefits Program, this payment is automatic and you will receive it annually.

Please check your bank account/statement (or the mail, if you are receiving a physical check) for your payment.

Announcement Hernando 10-13 Web Site



To access the web Site type <u>www.hernando10-13.com</u> and you will be directed to the web Site.



If your retired ID card is going to expire, has expired or has been lost & wish to renew your ID Card via the mail, please fill out the attached form & give it to Your club President.

They will be sent to the messenger directly by your club President.

If you lost your ID Card or it was stolen the form must be accompanied by a Police Report from your local Police Department or Sheriff's office.
