As the roll is called by God.*

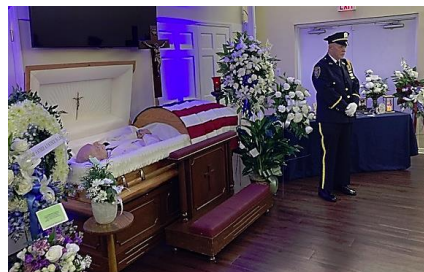
*Smith and Valone you gave your lives,
