




9/11 Memorial Services Wednesday September 11th 2024)

Several 9/11 Memorial Services were attended by members of the Hernando 10-13 club marking the 23rdh anniversary of the most lethal attack in history on American soil. A commemoration of the 2,977 people killed when 19 terrorists from half a world away hijacked and turned four commercial aircraft into missiles that rained death on New York City, the Pentagon, and a field in rural Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

Along with 343 firefighters who were killed, 72 law enforcement personnel also died in the attacks.

The first service of the day was held at the VFW Post #10209 at 14736 Edward R. Noll Dr., Spring Hill at 8:30am, in conjunction with the VFW and FDNY. The Hernando 10-13 Honor Guard and RMP participated.























<u>The second 9/11 Memorial Service for the day</u> was held at 11:00am at Wellington at Seven Hills Club House located at 400 Wexford Blvd. Spring Hill, FL 34609. The Honor Guard and RMP participated.







The final 9/11 Remembrance Ceremony of the day was at the Timber Pines Republican Club, 872 Timber Pines Blvd Spring Hill Fl 3460. The Hernando 10-13 Honor Guard presented the Colors.




