The September 2023 COLA is 2.5 percent, for a maximum annual increase of \$450.00, or \$37.50 per month before taxes. If you are eligible for COLA and you receive your pension payment through direct deposit, you will also receive a <u>notification of the net change</u> in your monthly pension amount at the end of September.









