Ticket Information:

1 Director/Founder and 2 coaches will receive free admission. Children 3 and under are free. Advance ticket sales will begin September 1st, 2023 and will end, September 25th, 2023. Advance tickets will be \$25.00. Beginning September 26th tickets will be \$35.00. Advance ticket sales will end on October 20th, 2023.

There will be no more advance tickets sold after 11:59, October 20, 2023.

We strongly suggest advance ticket purchases. Door Admission will be \$40 if there are tickets available for sale during this time.

Once our Messenger Group is created with all teams, we will then provide the event ticket link to purchase advance tickets. The tickets will only be made available for sale for the dates listed above in the packet. Once payment is received for all tickets, designated colored wristbands will be available upon team check-in upon arrival to the competition to Director, Founder, Coach or Designated Staff member.

Categories:

*All teams must participate in **ALL** categories in order to qualify for Grand Champs, no exceptions! If you fail to inform us prior to the competition that your team will not participate in any category will automatically disqualify you from grand champ. This is imperative that we know ahead of time which categories your team will and will not compete. *

1. WALK-THRU

Teams will present their parade routine to judges and events patrons. Teams will combine their Minis, Juniors and Seniors squads to represent their team. Each team will be given **5 minutes max for this category. The perimeter of the floor must be utilized ONLY during this performance.**

If the middle of the floor is used during this performance, your team will receive a 10-point deduction from each judge, also if you go over the time limit, 10 points will be deducted from each judge. Teams are to provide their own music. MUSIC MUST BE CLEAN.

2. CREATIVE

Teams will combine their Mini, Junior and Senior squads, to represent their team and present a **5-7-minute max** performance with a Creative Theme. Failure to adhere will result in a 10-point deduction from each judge. You choose music and theme. While we anticipate this to be a fun category, please

let us keep it clean and respectful for everyone. GET CREATIVE and HAVE FUN!!!!

FYI, if your team goes over the time limit 10 points will be deducted from each judge.

3. TRIO

Teams will combine a Coach, the Team Head Captain and a Mini Captain to represent their team and present a 3 minute TRIO performance. TRIO must dance separately and together not to exceed 3 minutes.

*****This category must consist of a COACH, TEAM HEAD CAPTAIN and MINI CAPTAIN*****

There will be a total of **3 minutes max** performance time.

*****You are required to pick your own music for this category*****

*****ALL Music must be clean. *****

FYI, if your team exceeds the maximum 3 min, your team will be disqualified from this category. Also, if music is not clean, points will also be deducted.

4. STANDS – *ALL AGES COMBINED STAND BATTLE*** (Ages 2-18)**

Mini Captain – Must throw 1 fast stand round

Junior Captain – Must throw 1 fast stand round

Senior Captain will throw 1 Medium and 1 slow round. (Minis are not required to dance in SLOW round)

All rounds will include: Combined All Age Division- ages 2 to 18 years old.

4 rounds:

2 fast songs at 1 minute and 30 seconds max

1 medium song at 1 minute 30 seconds max

1 slow song at 2 min. max.

Music will be provided by Competition Host.

***It will be up to the team and at your Coach's discretion if you would like to utilize your minis in the slow stand battle round, however, it is not required or mandatory for them to perform during the slow round. It is required for them to perform the fast and medium rounds. ***

Time will start on the 2nd cling (after the cling is thrown, the second movement should be performed by the entire team).

- ❖ Stands should be thrown as soon as the opposing team is finish with their stand.
 - ❖ There should be no movement from opposing team while stands are being thrown.
 - ❖ Teams are NOT allowed to cross the designated disqualification line.
 - ❖ Disqualification line will be announced by host, prior to the beginning of each stand battle.
 - ❖ Coaches nor other team members may signal to captain which stand to be thrown next.
 - ❖ Absolutely no counting from coaches allowed during stand battles.
 - ❖ There will be zero tolerance for profanity, obscene gestures and un-sportsman like conduct during all performances. Any violation of these terms by **COACHES, FANS, or TEAMMATES** will result in automated disqualification from the entire competition!
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Your team will be judge based on the following categories:

- ❖ Technique ❖ Synchronization ❖ Creativity ❖ Musicality ❖ Facial Expressions
- ❖ Energy ❖ Overall Appearance and Performance

Trophies and Prizes:

1st thru 3rd place trophies will be awarded to Walk-Thru, Creative, TRIO and Stand Battle.

\$100 cash prize will be awarded for 1st place Walk-Thru; \$100 cash prize will be awarded for 1st place Creative.

Grand Champion will be awarded \$800 cash prize with 8 foot trophy.

Judges Scoring Rubric

NOTE: At no time are Directors, Coaches, volunteers, team members, or spectators allowed to approach the judging table or judges. Doing so could result in your team being disqualified from the category they are currently performing in. THE SCORING WILL BE BASED ON THE CHOSEN JUDGES DECISION AND THEY CAN SCORE BASED ON THE TEAMS PERFORMANCE 1 - 10 FOR EXAMPLE.

For stand battle round, it is an elimination-based scoring system. THERE WILL BE NO SCORE SHEETS IN THIS CATEGORY.

It is the responsibility of each dance group to monitor all belongings. Jeweled Diamonds Dance Company, and/or any of its affiliates will NOT be responsible for any lost/stolen items.

Check-in Times and Music:

Team check -in will be prompt! Check-in will begin at 9:00 a.m. All teams **MUST** be checked in by 10:00 a.m. Teams will not be allowed to check in until all dancers are present. All teams **MUST** check in together. **Any teams checked in after 10:30 a.m. will automatically forfeit their floor time.** Floor time will begin at 10:30 a.m. All teams will receive 5 mins of floor time. Floor time will be assigned according to the time of arrival of each time. *Ex. First team to check-in will receive the first slot for floor time.

Room Clean-up/Deposit:

There will be a \$100 deposit for your room. Please be sure to clean your room thoroughly prior to departure. Once your room has been checked and verified as clean, your deposit will be returned.

The award ceremony will not begin until each area is cleaned.

Music: October 20, 2023 via email jeweleddiamonds2020@gmail.com. IF MUSIC IS NOT TURNED IN BY DUE DATE, 5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED EACH DAY UNTIL RECEIVED.

On the day of competition, audio equipment will be available for use for competing teams and other identified event affiliates.

The DJ has requested to submit all music via e-mail to jeweleddiamonds2020@gmail.com no later than October 20, 2023 and also bring your music as back up on a USB/flash drive upon check- in on the day of the competition.

Please label your material to include your team's name and track number(s). We ask that (1) coach/team representative be present at the DJ table during your team's performance in each category.

Each team will need to provide their own competition audio materials, this excludes Stand Battle Tracks. Stand battle music will be provided by event sponsor.

There will be a canteen. If you are any member of your team is caught sneaking in food or getting someone else to bring or sneak in food and you are caught, you may be asked to dispose and if not, you risk your team being disqualified for not following the rules set forth in this official packet.
