The Arts & Crafts venues will be open to the public **Friday through Sunday**, **June 12–16**, **2024 beginning at 9 a.m.** Setup may occur on June 13, but no sales may occur until June 14. Vendors may stay open after dark during carnival hours, but it is not required. The location will be below the dam, north of the outlet channel at Grenada Lake, Grenada, MS. Pick up registration packet prior to setup at the Festival Information Center at the bottom of the levee on Toe Road. Setup prior to 7 **a.m. is prohibited.** 

The standard areas allowed for vendors are:

• 12' x 12' Arts & Crafts Space: \$195.00

If your booth requires more, additional space can be assigned to you for an additional fee. *Each* vendor must supply any electrical power needed! No vendor may sell guns, knives, or weapons of any kind. The sale of alcohol or hemp/cannabis products is also prohibited. No loud generators allowed. Grenada Lake Association has the right to inspect, accept, or deny any vendor.

If you wish to be added to our liability policy in lieu of getting your own policy and certificate, submit \$75 with application and a note. **Application Deadline is May 1.**
