

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### ARLINGWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

The undersigned, intending to form a Virginia nonstock corporation pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia, state as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

##### CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is Arlingwood Neighborhood Association.

#### ARTICLE II

##### PURPOSES

Promote the general welfare of the Arlingwood Neighborhood and its residents in a non-partisan manner, and represent its residents as a Member of the Arlington County Civic Federation.

Work in cooperation to protect the property rights of its residents with respect to change, improvement, development issues and beautification within the neighborhood boundaries and adjunct County, Commonwealth, and Federal properties.

Upkeep and maintenance of the Arlingwood Green.

#### ARTICLE III

##### BOUNDARIES AND MEMBERS

**Boundaries.** Arlingwood's area is bounded by the Potomac River, both sides of southbound North Glebe Road up to the North Old Glebe Road overpass, then North Glebe Road, the boundary of the Chain Bridge Forest Association, and the Fairfax County Line.

**Eligible Members.** Any adult over 18 years of age who resides in a household within the boundaries of Arlingwood, or who owns a home within the boundaries of Arlingwood, is eligible

for Membership in the Association with full rights and privileges. However, the President of the Association has the right to require written verification of eligibility of any applicant for membership in the Association at any time.

**Admission of Eligible Members.** Any adult eligible under (3) of this Article will become a member of the Association upon payment of the dues prescribed pursuant to the Bylaws. Each member will have one vote at any regular meeting of the Association.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

##### **OFFICERS**

**Officers.** There will be three Officers of the Association: President, Vice President, and Secretary/Treasurer. At the annual meeting, the members will elect officers for a term of one year.

**Executive Committee.** An Executive Committee consisting of the Officers are empowered to take all necessary action on behalf of the Association between meetings of the Membership.

**Vacancies.** If a vacancy occurs between meetings, the President or Vice President may seek a volunteer from the membership to complete the term. Failure of an Officer to attend two consecutive member meetings without an excused absence will be considered to create a vacancy in that position.

#### **ARTICLE V**

##### **REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE**

The name of the corporation's initial registered agent is Byron Johnson, who is a resident of Virginia and an initial director of the corporation.

The address of the corporation's initial registered office, which is identical to the business office of the initial registered agent, is 4121 N. Randolph Street, Arlington VA 22207. The registered office is located in the County of Arlington.


