MEDITATION

I HAVE MUCH TO SAY TO YOU, HEART OF MY LONGING. One of the greatest deceptions of the enemy is to convince souls that not only do I not speak to them, but that it is hard to hear Me. If you know that you are a son/daughter of your Father you can easily flow in the truth that I will speak to you building you up, encouraging you, and console you. My voice is not hidden from those whom the Father has chosen as His own. Prayer is not a one-way venture where you speak and I listen. No, remember, at the center of all the ways of the Kingdom is the principle that everything is built upon relationships. Prayer is just one of the ways you and I can connect. In it I speak and you listen and you speak and I listen. The way to pray that I am offering you is an ongoing conversation. Let Me speak to you in that familiar, still, small voice in the depth of your heart. Do not let a day pass when we do not speak to each other. I have much to tell you about yourself, about Me and My ways, and to give you the guidance that you need from Me, Me alone.

To hear My voice, it is important that you believe that I will speak to you. Hearing from Me is hard for you just because you are not used to the fact that I would talk to you. Come to Me with an open heart to listen and an open ear to hear. I will lead you and guide you, Heart of My Longing, if you let Me do so. Today, sit before Me with great expectation that I will speak if you would but hear. Live a life centered in Me. Trust that what comes to your heart in that still, small, familiar voice is My voice. Many make the mistake of entering into listening prayer, starting from a point of doubt. They do this by being hyper concerned that they will hear their thoughts or, even, be influenced by the enemy. The first stance in hearing is that of doubt and disbelief. Let this not be your stance. Come to me with confidence, My Faithful Friend, trusting that you will hear from Me. After you have allowed your spirit to enjoy My presence and My voice, then, and only then, can you truly discern. Do not start from a place of disbelief, rather, stand in the place of Divine Adoption, knowing who you are and all that I long to be for you, and listen, knowing that I am ready to speak to you. Believe Me, we are about to have some great, powerful, life-changing conversations as you allow My voice to comfort, exhort, and edify you.

IOURNAL EXERCISE:

How do you feel about the idea that God would speak to you and that the normal flow of prayer is a dialogue with the Spirit speaking to you and you speaking to the Spirit?

Ask the Holy Spirit to show you somethings you can do to help you to listen and hear His voice lead and guide you. What is He showing you?
