## **Rosary for Struggling Marriage**

### **Joyful Mysteries**

#### **Annunciation and Incarnation (Lk 1:26-38)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Annunciation come down into my beloved's soul that their guardian angel might invite them into a deeper union with the Lord Jesus through our marriage.

"...blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus, who longs for our marriage to make him known by our love for each other."

#### **Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth (Lk 1:39-56)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Visitation come down into my beloved's soul that they might remember the mighty things that God has done for them through our marriage.

"....blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who has done great things through our marriage."

#### **Birth of Our Lord (Lk 2:1-20)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Birth of our Lord come down into my beloved's soul that Jesus might be the center of their life through our marriage.

"...blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, whose delight is to dwell in the midst of our marriage."

#### **Presentation of Our Lord (Lk 2:22-38)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Presentation come down into my beloved's soul that they might present their life in surrender to the Father by living out our Sacramental Covenant of Matrimony.

"...blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who lifts our marriage as a gift to the Father."

#### **Finding Child Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-52)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Finding in the Temple come down into my beloved's soul that a hunger might awaken in their heart to search after God through the gift of our Sacrament.

"...blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who draws our hearts to find him in our marriage."

## **Luminous Mysteries**

### **Baptism of our Lord Jesus (Mk 1:9-11)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Baptism of our Lord Jesus come down into my beloved's soul that they might remember who they have become through the waters of Baptism, a son/daughter of God who, because of the Sacrament of Matrimony, is able to love with Divine Love.

“...blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, in whom we have become a son/daughter of God.”

### **Wedding Feast at Cana (Jn 2:1-12)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Wedding Feast at Cana come down into my beloved's soul that they might allow Christ to change their life from water to wine, from ordinary to the extraordinary through our Sacramental Covenant of Marriage.

“... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who is conforming us to his Divine Life through our marriage.”

### **Proclamation of the Kingdom (Mt 4:17)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Proclamation of the Kingdom come down into my beloved's soul that they might be given the grace to repent and forgive.

“...blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who offers us the grace to repent and forgive each other.”

### **Transfiguration of our Lord (Mt 17:1-8)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Transfiguration come down into my beloved's soul that they begin to listen in prayer so as to hear the voice of Jesus speaking the truth that sets free and heals.

“... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, whose voice of truth sets us free and heals us.”

### **Institution of the Eucharist (Mt 26:26-30)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Institution of the Eucharist come down into my beloved's soul that my beloved and I would give our lives in sacrificial love for each other as Jesus gives his life to us at the Eucharist.

“.... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who will give us his Eucharistic Life of sacrificial love at our next communion.”

## **Sorrowful Mysteries**

### **Agony in the Garden (Lk 22:39-46)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Agony in the Garden come down into my beloved's soul that they might cultivate a life of prayer.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who longs to draw my beloved and me into a life of deeper prayer."

### **Scourging at Pilar (Jn 19:1-3)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Scourging at the Pilar come down into my beloved's soul that they might be healed of any hurt I or others have caused them.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who is the healer of our marriage."

### **Crowning with Thorns (Mt 27:29)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Crowning of Thorns come down into my beloved's soul that they may be delivered from unrighteous thoughts.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who is the healer of our memories."

### **Carrying the Cross (Mk 15:20-21)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Carrying of the Cross come down into my beloved's soul that they might deny themselves and accept the will of God for our marriage.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who will help us deny our self-will."

### **Crucifixion and Death of our Lord (Jn 19:16-37)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Crucifixion and Death of our Lord come down into my beloved's soul that they might be set free of any feelings of being abandoned by God.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who thirsts for us to experience the Father's unconditional love through our marriage."

## **The Glorious Mysteries**

### **Resurrection of our Lord (Lk 24)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Resurrection of our Lord come down into my beloved's soul that they might be convinced that Christ alone is their source of peace for themselves and our marriage.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who is the source of peace in our marriage."

### **Ascension of our Lord (Ac 1:6-12)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Ascension of our Lord come down into my beloved's soul that they and our marriage might serve him who is King of kings and Lord of lords.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who draws us to surrender to his Lordship in our marriage."

**Descent of the Holy Spirit (Ac 2:1-41)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Descent of the Holy Spirit come down into my beloved's soul that they might be filled afresh with the Holy Spirit as on the day of their Baptism and Confirmation, and on the day of our marriage.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, whose Spirit is ready to inhabit our marriage."

**Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary come down into my beloved's soul that they might live for God and our marriage serve God alone.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who stands ready to share all the blessings of Divine Life with us through our Sacrament of Matrimony."

**Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth (Rev 12:1)**

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the grace of the Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth come down into my beloved's soul that they might come, through our marriage, to share in the life of the Saints in the Father's glory.

"... blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, who waits in joyful expectation to spend eternity with my beloved and me."
