## "Symbols & Titles of the Holy Spirit"

**Focus Verse**  
**Ez 37:14**  
I will put my Spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I the LORD have spoken, and I have done it, declares the LORD

### 2 Review the Talk:

## Symbols of the Holy Spirit

**Brooding/Hovering**  
Gen 1:1-2. In Hebrew the image is that of a hen over her young. The Spirit of God is waiting in expectancy over your life.

**Water**  
Cleanse us with clean water (Ez 37:25-27)  
Two sins: Forsaken God, the spring of living water and dug their own cisteran (Jer 2:13)  
Streams of living water from within (Jn 7:37-38)  
Going deeper in the Spirit (Ez 47:1-6)  
Drink the water of life (Rev 22:17)

**Breath**  
Spirit of God, *Ruach Elohim* in Hebrew.  
Holy Spirit is our Creator (Job 33:4)  
"The Lord is closer to us than we are to our own breath" *St Augustine*  
Jesus breathed on the Apostles (Jn 20:19-22)

**Anointing Oil**  
We are anointed (2 Cor 1:21-22)  
"As Christ was anointed priest, prophet and king, so may you live always as a member of his holy people, sharing everlasting life".  
*Rite of Baptism*  
The Holy Spirit tells us who we are and what our mission is in the Kingdom of God: The Holy Spirit comes to empower you as a priest, prophet and king.  
You, believer, as a priest, prophet, and a king.  
The anointing brings unity (Ps 133:1-2)

**Fire**  
The fire of God at Pentecost (Ac 2:1-4)  
God is a consuming fire (Deut 4:24, Is 33:14, Heb 12:29)  
Moses and the Burning Bush (Ex 3:1-14)  
Fire from heaven consumes the sacrifice (Lev 9)  
We are a living sacrifice (Ro 12:1-2)  
Believers are now the temple of God (1 Cor 3:16)  
Do not put out the fire of the Spirit (1 Thes 5:19)

# Lectio Divina

**Lectio** (To Read) Read the passage slowly, two or three times believing that God is going to speak into your life. Notice the words or phrases that speak to you.

**Meditatio** (To Meditate) Allow this Word to begin to sift through your life. What is God speaking to you?

**Oratio** (To Speak) Now that God has spoken to you through His word, what is your response? Use the ACTS of prayer: **A**doration, **C**ontrition, **T**hanksgiving, **S**upplication? Speak to God freely.

**Contemplatio** (To Contemplate) Read back over the passage and review your dialogue with God. Become quiet and turn your heart to His heart for you. Is there anything that He personally wants to speak to you?
