### Lectio Divina (Divine Reading)

**Lectio-** *to read:* Look up and then write the passage down. As you read have faith that God is speaking to you personally.

**Meditatio** – *to meditate*: What is God saying to you? Use who, what, where, when, why.

**Oratio** – *to speak*: Speak to God about what He is saying to you. *Note: Meditatio and Oratio can flow back and forth between you and the Holy Spirit as it is a conversation.*
