MEDIATION

GIVE THANKS THAT YOU ARE BLESSED WITH THE GIFT OF FAITH, HEART OF MY

LONGING. It is my greatest joy to bring you into relationship with the Father and the Son. The gift whereby you say "yes" to surrendering to the bond of love that We offer you is the gift of faith. You will know Us and in your knowing, your love for Us will become more than you ever imagined, because it will be the gift which We have given you, you accepting, and not something for which you have strived or comprehended. What We offer in our covenant relationship of Us being yours and you being Ours is the fulfillment of your ever aspiration, desire, and yearning. We are yours, totally and completely, Beloved Bride.

Faith is also stepping into the place where you allow Us to do for you all that We have promised that We long to do for you. Many ascent to the truth that We exist, but few will move to the place of trustful surrender by laying their needs before Us. Most believers, hear Me that I am speaking of believers, do not take the step of trusting Us, based on who We are, to do the things which they need Us to do for them. They continue to live as if everything comes down to what they have which then limits what they can do. In this they come to live under the Law of Scarcity. This is a cruel Law under which to live for it exposes the need and your measure to meet that need, leaving you in want, and even, at times, despair. Living under the lie of the Law of Scarcity is the Law of the enemy's kingdom. Fear is his mode of operation as faith is Our way. All We have is unveiled and placed at your disposal as your heart stands before Us in trustful surrender. The more you know who We are to you, the more you will know what We long to do for you. Grow in the experienced knowledge of Us by reading our Word and believing its promises. Find these promises, and stand on them, patiently waiting for their fulfillment. Our Word is life for your life. Another way to grow in the knowledge of what We long to do for you is the testimony of the saints, both of the past and the present. Their witness of Us will increase your faith to let go to trustful

surrender. Avail yourself to the stories of your Brothers and Sisters of Light. Please, please walk in faith and be that light for others so that they might hear and believe. Faith is trustful surrender to Our provision, cooperating with what We offer to you, so, Soul of Trustful Surrender, walk by faith in who We are and what We long to do for you.
