MEDITATION

ONE STEP AFTER ANOTHER IS HOW CREATION IS DESIGNED TO WORK, HEART OF MY LONGING. Let your imagination take you, for just a moment, to seeing how vast is the expanse of the universe, and the intricacies of all that I have made. I am God. I am all-powerful. I could have, as you say, snapped My fingers and all that is could have come to be, instead I took 6 days, periods, stages to create. Each day of the Creation Account is building on the day before, with each day the creation became more and more complex until it reached its height and purpose, which is mankind. Each day I labored making sure to complete that which was needed for the rest of creation. Everything I made is intertwined with other elements of creation, thus weaving a complete picture of what I wanted to be. I have chosen that word correctly when I said that each day I labored. Each day was a day of fine art, masterfully crafted and formed. Each day would leave the greatest scientists in awe of the complexity of the slightest of My creations. There are things that will never be discovered by man outside of eternity that causes My heart to be filled with joy when I gaze upon it, even to this day. What I am trying to say is that because I am God, I could have made all that is in a simple moment, but I took a period of time to fulfill My purposes and plans.

Taking time is an expression of patience, My Co-creating Friend. I have wired the Way of Patience into My plans and purposes. When you do not recognize my strategy of taking time, patience, you run the risk of living a life of frustration which then can easily lead to anger. Do you see the progression? The enemy knows My strategy woks, and so he entices you to move quickly through the process, and since moving quickly is not My plan, you end up frustrated. Patiently taking one step at a time, fulfilling this step before you move to the next, is how I have designed most things to progress. For some people that anger even leads resentment, which then unfolds to unforgiveness; unforgiveness leads to retaliation; when retaliation grows by the light of darkness it brings forth hatred; hatred then blossoms into violence, and even, murder. This is the deadening growth process which slays the heart, leaving it to love itself in justification. My heart grieves for these souls with a sigh that is beyond your experience, for it comes out of an unending love for them. Instead of being enticed to this slide into dark obscurity, allow Me to give to you all that you need to walk slowly through every step of your life, be it in your relationships, your goals, and even the spiritual life, gleaning from each step all that I would have you enjoy. I am here, impatiently patient to give you the patience you need to make sure My willed purposes and plans are utterly accomplished. From this day

forward, let us take our time as we watch our plans unfold into something of which we can stand in awe and enjoy.
