
MEDITATION

KINDNESS IS WHAT YOU ARE SEEKING IN OTHERS AND WHAT OTHERS WANT YOU TO BE FOR THEM, HEART OF MY LONGING. When it comes down to it, when considering relationships there is one thing that is an initial reaction to which you respond as to whether you will continue in a relationship with the other. It is a base need. It is the need for kindness. Kindness is not an idea. It is an experience of the other which is either there or it is not. Kindness makes room for the other in one's life, spending the time and the investment of self to be there with the other; it looks to make sure that one is not doing something to outright offend the other, and if it does offend, kindness moves one to ask for forgiveness; and kindness anticipates the needs of the other, looking for ways, if one can, to meet those needs. Kindness looks for the opportunity to speak well of the other, helping others to see how amazing is the one of who you are speaking. Kindness is always looking for the best interest of the other. Kindness looks for the good in the other and highlights that good. Kindness is not something you should lightly dismiss when you do not receive it in a relationship. Pay attention to its presence or its absence.

I give you all you need, My friend, to be kind. No matter what the person is like before you, you can always respond with their best interest in mind, which is kindness. It brings Me great delight when I meet a soul that is kind, for that soul is being like Us, the Trinity. We are kind. We are always making room for the other in our time and consideration. We are always anticipating your need and have many ways that we can help meet that need. There is not one conversation which the Father, Jesus, and I have had about you that does not speak of the good that we see in you and how we are ready to help you to grow in goodness. Because we are this way, we invite you into our way, supplying all that you need to be the kindest person someone will meet. How's that for a reputation?

When another person is devoid or short of kindness it is natural for us to move away from being in relationship with the other. We might not denounce them, but we find ourselves keeping distance. Why? Because kindness is a basic need of a righteous relationship.
