MEDITATION

YOUR MISSION IS JESUS' MISSION, HEART OF MY LONGING. Love has always been our way, and love will always be our way. Everything We are and do as the Trinity is because We are love. The Father created man out of love for love. Man turned away from Us, choosing himself, and with the shattering of Our relationship with him, all his relationship began to shatter, fracturing him from Us, from others, from creation, and, even from himself. Love seeks to be in union with the other. It is the essence of love. In love there no division. By the original sin, man separated himself from Us, losing, not only his physical life, but Our life, the Divine Life within him. Man could do nothing to repair this chasm, so Jesus, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, said, because of love, *"Here, I am. Send me."* He decided, as God, that he would become man and do for man what man could not do for himself. Man could not reach God, but God could reach man. And, so our adventure of love moved history step by step to prepare for his coming. The Father so love the world that He sent Jesus, the God-Man, the perfect man who was perfectly surrendered to, Me, the Holy Spirit. He came to make at-one-ment, to unite God to man so that man might be united to God. He came to reverse the curse. Where there was sin, sorrow, or sickness, Jesus brought grace, comfort, and healing. Where the kingdom of darkness was ruling and reigning, Jesus brought the Kingdom of the Father, inviting all to live under the rule and reign of a loving, generous Father. Jesus ascended to the Father that you might have his greatest gift – Me! He is now the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, ruling and reigning for his Father until he places all under his feet.

He began the work and spread of the Kingdom, but, now, passed that work to you, Victorious Son, Victorious Daughter. He has sent you to complete the work, by My power, until all is placed under his feet. How is all placed under his feet for as you can see there is still sin, sorrow, and sickness in your midst? You. You are how is continuing to place all under his feet. He is sending you as the Father sent him. He has given you all his authority and power. His mission from the Father is your mission from the Father. You are called to no less and no more than the continued mission of Jesus to bring grace, comfort, and healing; to complete this mission of the Father. Do not be overwhelmed at such a vast and weighty call. Notice, Jesus did not begin his mission of the proclamation and demonstration of the Kingdom until I rested upon him. Did I not tell you that I am in you from your baptism for your salvation, your healing, your deliverance, and that I come upon you for the salvation, healing, and deliverance of others? In a few I would like to come upon you as I came upon the apostles on the Day of Pentecost. It was on that Day that I Empowered them and sent them, and so I wish to do the same your life. In a few days you will be clothed with

power from on high. For this we have been journeying, Soul of Trustful Surrender. You are about to answer the call, for souls are hungry for Jesus. You are about to answer the call, for the Father is about to send you as He sent Jesus. You are about to answer the call, for souls are waiting for you.
