DAY 40 MORNING PRAYER

Psalm 139

MEDITATION

BEGIN TO PREPARE FOR THE GRACE OF THE BAPTISM IN THE SPIRIT, HEART OF MY LONGING. Today, we begin our novena, nine days of prayer, like the apostles preparing for Pentecost, expecting to receive My presence and power on the tenth day so that you might be my witness to the ends of the earth. Today, I will begin to pour into you a new grace to prepare you to receive Me afresh, and for some, anew, with My presence and power. In the waters of baptism, I filled you for the first time, washing away original sin, and I made you a new creation, a son or daughter of the Father, taking up my dwelling within you. In baptism you became a citizen and partaker of all that Jesus is and has purchased for you on the Cross. In baptism you were removed from the Kingdom of darkness and made a member, citizen of the Kingdom of God, with all its rights and inheritance coming from your new covenant with Jesus. I came into you in baptism for your salvation. On the day of your baptism we first entered into our covenant- you, being mine; and I, being yours. How I loved the day of your baptism. We celebrated you in heaven, that day, and all heard the Father declare as he did with Jesus on his day of baptism, "*This is my beloved in whom I am well pleased.*" I had waited and waited for that day, for I set My eyes on you from the first day the plan was laid before the Heavenly Host. I saw you across time to the time when you would become in the womb of your mother. From that day, I counted with joyful expectation, the days until your baptism. As I have told you, my delight is to be with you, and it is a delight for Me to share in every aspect of your life.

In a few days, the 50th Day, I am coming upon you for the salvation of others by clothing you with power. The 50th Day is when I came upon the apostles, clothing them with power. It was the Feast of Pentecost, Shavuot. I want you to have what they had, and I want you to experience with they experienced. I want to overshadow you with My abiding presence, so that where you go, I go, bringing with Me, eagerly ready to give to you, all you need to be a witness through proclamation and demonstration of the Gospel of the Kingdom. On the 50th Day, Jesus will grant to you the

grace of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. On that Day, I will grant to you the gift of a heavenly prayer language, the gift of tongues, and the gift of prophecy that you might hear My voice. On that day I will distribute to you manifestations of My presence – wisdom and word of Knowledge; faith, gifts of healing, and miracles; prophecy, tongues, and interpretation of tongues. These are the charismatic gifts which I give you for others. Faith, hope, and love are for your sanctification, as well as fear of the Lord and piety; counsel, wisdom, and fortitude; knowledge and understanding. I am coming upon you, Sent One, so that you might re-present Jesus in mission and ministry. It is time to prepare your heart in these final nine days to receive the grace of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit.

and adoring his open side and pierced heart,
I implore You,
Spirit of Oblation,
You who are worthy of my adoration,
Helper of in my infirmity,
to keep me in Your Divine Life of sanctifying grace that I may never sin against You ever
again.

Holy Spirit, Triune God,
Spirit of the Father and the Son,
help me to pray to You in all situations,
"Speak Lord for your servant is listening,"
that I might always know and do the Father's will in all things and at all times.
