MEDITATION

YOU WERE MADE TO BE FREE, HEART OF MY LONGING. I see your soul. I see your struggle and your desire to be free. You say to Me, "*Lord, I do not want this. I will never do it again,*" and then you find yourself in the very place, doing the very thing that you do not want to do. For years you have cried out and asked for My deliverance. Know that I am ready to come to your aid and unleash you from the very thing that in so many ways you despise. I have not stood over you in judgement, Broken One. I have heard your cry for help, and it has filled My heart with compassion. It is not that I did not come to your aid. It is that you were not ready for My grace to settle upon you to allow you to walk in freedom. Now is the time and I stand here ready to do for you that which you could not do for yourself. You might wonder why it took so many days to get to the point of addressing your need for freedom. It is because I had to firmly convince you of My love, My tenderness, and My closeness. I also needed to set you free of the biggest hinderance to your freedom, self-reliance. I have placed into the depth of your being the truth that will

set you free, the truth of *"I can't. God can. I will let him."* This simple pattern of truth has made a path in your heart for you to turn to Me in trustful surrender, so what is it that binds you, that holds you back from walking in the glorious freedom of the sons and daughters of God? Be honest with Me. You do not need to hide any longer. Please do not lower your eyes as if I would look on you with shame. Look at Me, Beloved. Gaze into My eyes in the candor and sincerity of what you have done and the captivity of what you have chosen. Shame says, *"What's the matter with me?"* It is not *"What's the matter."* It is, *"What is missing?"* What was missing is your trustful surrender, and now you have that grace. Can you trust Me with what is missing that holds you in your prison of self harming self? Again, we traveled together through this time, so that now you are ready. Give it to Me and watch what I can do. Your chains are about to fall off and your prison door is about to open. What do you think of that, Heart of My Longing? This is the day the Lord has made, so rejoice and be glad in it. I am ready to do for you what you cannot do for yourself. You might think that this is too easy. I know. I know. It is too good to be true. Yes, it is good, but it is not too good to be true, for it is true. Sit back, hold open your hands and say, *"I am ready, Holy Spirit. Do for me what I cannot do for myself."* As I write, the anticipation of all that I am about to do for you causes My heart to race. How about yours? You are ready, because I am ready.
