The purpose of our subdivision restrictions is to maintain a uniform high quality in the homes in the Woodlands and to protect property values for all homeowners, present and future, in this subdivision. We can all agree that we want to live in a well-maintained neighborhood and get the highest dollar amount when/if we need to sell our homes. Letters will soon be sent to homeowners who are not in compliance with the subdivision restrictions. Some of the most common violations include:

- Sidewalk has overgrown grass, dirt/sand, or fallen branches/limbs
- Sidewalk is blocked by bushes/shrubs or low hanging tree branches
- Sidewalk is blocked by parked cars
- Vehicles are parked on the street
- Vehicles are parked on the lawn

I encourage our homeowners to take this opportunity to correct any of these violations now before the letters go out to individual homeowners who are not in compliance.

Dog Reminders

- There have been numerous reports of dogs running loose in the neighborhood. We have also
 had a report of someone being bitten. PLEASE be sure to keep your dogs securely fenced in
 or on a leash to avoid other people or animals being attacked and injured.
- We have also had complaints of dog walkers not picking up their dog's poop! Picking up after your dog is YOUR responsibility! It is also your responsibility to dispose of the bag of waste, which means not throwing the bag in the storm drain or your neighbor's trash can.

Slow Down!

Homeowners, please remember the speed of the roadways in the Woodlands. This is especially important with all the children playing in the area. Please use extra caution and slow down to avoid collisions with each other, pedestrians, animals, signs, etc.
