For several years now, Anne has wanted a garden to grow fresh vegetables for us to eat. However, our yard did not seem conducive for such an endeavor. Too many trees, not enough sun. When we lived at the lake it would have been a field of dreams for the deer. However, through a little thinking outside the box, this year Anne has her garden.

While we were renovating her parents house for us to call home, we pulled up most of the unkept shrubbery in front of the house with grand plans to replant. Yet, time got away from us and we never did. That's when Anne thought, what about a small garden? Plenty of sun... enough space to get started. And after a little prodding, I tilled the area and prepared the soil to receive the seeds. Anne planted, I watered (installed soaker hose), and God has caused the increase.

However, establishing a flourishing garden takes time and it would be easy to get discouraged as you witness the harvest of others. Though we have seen only a couple of cups of green beans, the creation of a sole tomato, and a few modest cucumbers and peppers that are still in need of growth, others have brought in an abundance of same items to share with others.

Isn't that the way it is with our Christian walk too?

I remember as I began my Christian walk just over 8 years ago, I wanted to know all the things my Christian brothers and sisters knew. I wanted to be able to do all the things they were doing. I had the desire... but like Anne's garden, I was a seed that had newly sprouted, and my soil still needed time to produce. Therefore, I immersed myself in Bible studies to be watered by God's Word, and He provided the increase in my faith.

Our church is like a garden as well. The soil must continually be worked, seeds continually planted, and watered by sharing the gospel and studying God's word. Though there had been marginal growth over the last two years, we have been faithful in our worship, in our serving, in our giving, and in our sharing of God's love and grace. As a result, we have seen an increase at Hopewell Church that has not been seen in quite some time. New ministries are blossoming, new members are joining, new births through baptism are taking place! However, let us not forget, we are called to plant and water... we give all the glory to God for the increase!

As we continue to be faithful to God and His word, I am excited to see the growth that is ahead for Hopewell Church. Therefore, keep planting and watering! A harvest is a coming!
