Yes, March 2 is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season that calls us to sacrifice through fasting, focus on our piety, and to reflect on our mortality. However, the light that shines at the end of Lent is our true light, which is Christ, whose resurrection gives us new life. Therefore, go tell the people all about this new life! The new life you have in Christ and the new life they will find at Hopewell church.


