

Your FREE Spinal Injury Checklist:

1. **Documenting the Injury**-Carefully documenting the full extent of the spinal injury through medical records, test results, and physician assessments. This creates a strong evidentiary trail.
2. **Establishing Liability**- Determining who was at fault for the accident that caused the injury, whether it was another driver, a defective product, or some other negligent party. This is key to building the liability case.
3. **Providing Appropriate Medical Treatment** - Ensuring the injured victim receives prompt and thorough medical care, including emergency stabilization, surgery if needed, rehabilitation, and any long-term treatment for the spinal injury. Documenting all treatment.
4. **Calculating Damages** - Thoroughly calculating all economic damages like medical bills, lost wages, and future lost earning capacity. Also documenting non-economic damages like pain, suffering, and quality of life impacts.
5. **Filing the Claim Properly**-Ensuring the personal injury claim is filed correctly with the appropriate court or insurance provider, and that all deadlines and procedures are properly followed.
6. **Negotiating a Fair Settlement** - Working with the at-fault party's insurance company to negotiate a full and fair settlement that adequately compensates the injured victim. If needed, being prepared to take the case to trial.

The goal is to build **the strongest possible case** to recover the maximum compensation allowed under Arizona personal injury laws. Careful documentation, establishing liability, **securing appropriate medical treatment**, and effective negotiation are critical priorities.
