

Your FREE Construction Zone Pedestrian Accident Injury Checklist:

- 1. Prioritize safety and seek medical attention:**
 - Move to a safe area if possible
 - Call 911 or seek immediate medical help
 - Get thorough medical evaluations, even for seemingly minor injuries
 - Keep all medical records and follow treatment plans
- 2. Document the accident scene:**
 - Take photos/videos of the area, including hazards and lack of proper signage
 - Capture the entire construction zone setup
 - Note weather conditions, time, and visibility factors
 - Document your injuries
- 3. Report the incident and gather information:**
 - Inform the on-site construction supervisor
 - File a police report and obtain a copy
 - Collect contact information for the construction company and contractors
 - Gather witness names and contact details
- 4. Preserve evidence and maintain records:**
 - Keep clothing and shoes worn during the incident unwashed
 - Save any physical evidence from the scene (if safely obtainable)
 - Retain all medical records, bills, and prescriptions
 - Keep a journal documenting pain, limitations, and recovery progress
- 5. Investigate and prepare for potential claims:**
 - Research local construction safety regulations and pedestrian laws
 - Track all expenses related to the injury, including lost wages
 - Be prepared for a complex case involving multiple parties
 - Discuss with your attorney potential compensation for medical bills, lost wages, pain and suffering, and long-term care if needed
