

GHOSTWRITNG



I can write your book from blank page to ending. OR, I love it even more when your book is a collaborative effort and you offer some of your writing and style while I fill in the gaps!

Step #1: Are we a good fit? Let's find out! We will message back and forth a few times about your subject matter, voice, and style. I will ask some questions and hope that you have a few for me.

Step #2: If we decide to work together, we can create a custom order for your desired word count and time frame. The order can be broken into 2500-5000 word milestones so it isn't so overwhelming.

Step #3: I will create an outline for your review and begin writing the intro and first chapter. You will get a progress report with the rough draft to ensure we are on track. From there, we will review, revise, and continue writing your book until finished!

GHOSTWRITING: WHAT YOU GET

- A published author and trained book editor to write for you.

EDITING

You did all the work and now need an editor to polish your masterpiece.

Step #1: Provide your manuscript for review. The industry standard is to give the editor your manuscript formatted to an 8.5x11 page size using a 12 pt Times New Roman font with double spacing. Your manuscript should be void of design elements and images unless you are in the final stage of proofreading.

Step #2: I will provide an estimate based on word count and the quality of the writing. This is at the sole discretion of the editor.

Step #3: Depending on the book length, I will give weekly updates. Longer projects will be broken into milestones. Editing often takes more than one pass and you should have realistic expectations on timelines.

EDITING IS "DEEP WORK"

Editing requires deep concentration coupled with the knowledge and understanding of language, writing, and the various style guides.

Editors will refer to the Chicago Manual of Style, the AP Style guide, The Merriam-Webster Dictionary, and others to ensure that your manuscript follows standard rules for writing. However, writing is also an art form. Therefore, an editor must determine whether "acceptable and agreed upon standards" should be followed or whether your words follow a writing style unique to you and the message you are trying to convey. For example, commas, semicolons, and em dashes are always in debate. One publisher or editor will tell you to stay away from semi colons while another will insist on them. This is why they use Style Sheets!

EDITING: STYLE SHEETS

Not all editors will offer a style sheet. However, if you are writing fiction, consider asking for one.

A style sheet will be the editors cheat sheet for how they handle specific editorial questions in your writing. For example, regional spelling choices could be considered. Will you follow US English or non US English spelling and word choice? Do you have specific slang or jargon? The editor will note narrative tense and point of view structure. Other considerations like how to handle abbreviations, chapter formatting, numbers, possessives, and even punctuation can be addressed in the style sheet.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

There are some things you can do that will help save time and show an editor that you are serious about your manuscript. Follow these tips and it may even save you money on editing services!

- Personally edit your manuscript FIRST. Do a spell and grammar check.
- Make sure your headings, subheading, font, spacing, etc. are consistent.
- Submit a WORD file using an 8.5x11 page size
- 12pt New Times Roman font
- Double space your lines
- Do not include images or design elements
- Know what type of editing you need and your word count
- Be realistic on your timeline


