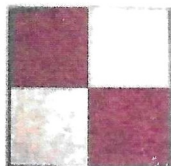
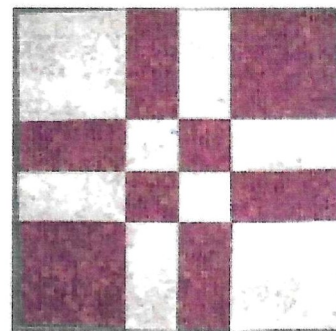


Block 1 – Standard Disappearing 4-Patch 11" X 11"

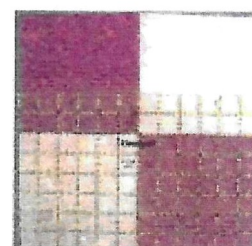
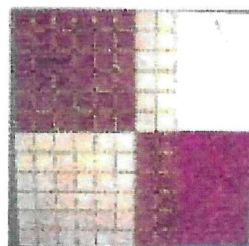
(2) 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" squares of light (background) fabric

(2) 6 1/2" X 6 1/2" squares of dark (primary) fabric

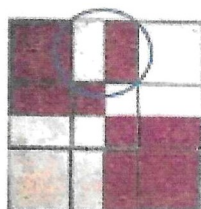
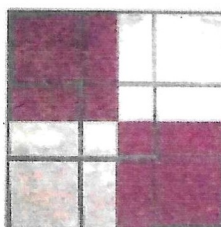


Step 1. Sew the 4 squares into a 4-Patch block.

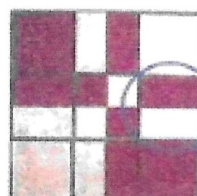
Step 2. Make 4 cuts. Each cut is 2" from the center line. Make the cuts right of the center, above the center, left of the center and bottom of the center. It is easier to rotate the mat than to rotate the block after each cut.



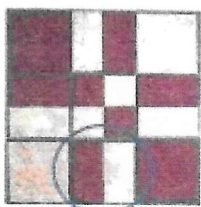
You now have 9 blocks.



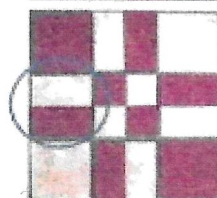
Step 3.
Rotate the top center block 180°



Step 4.
Rotate the center right block 180°

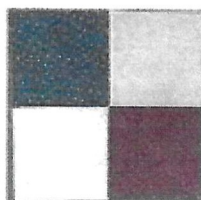


Step 5.
Rotate the bottom center block 180°



Step 6.
Rotate the center left block 180°

Step 7. Sew the nine pieces together as shown in Step 6.



When using multiple colors, the initial 4-patch and finished blocks will look similar to the images here.
