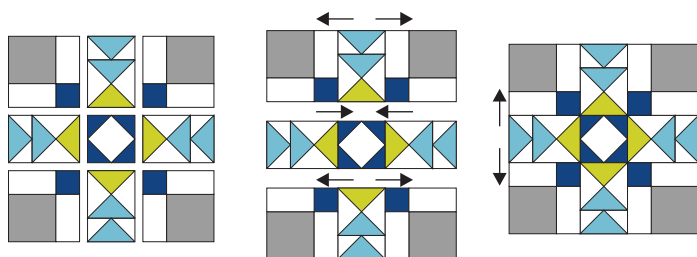


Block Assembly

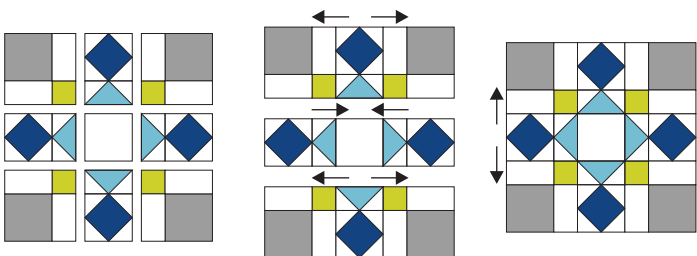
FIRST BLOCKS

1. Arrange the following units and pieces according to the illustration.
 4 first corner units $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
 4 first doublet units $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
 1 bg/A SiaS unit $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the units into rows, then sew the rows together, pressing the seams open or as indicated by the arrows, to make a first block $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Repeat to make a total of 4 first blocks.



SECOND BLOCKS

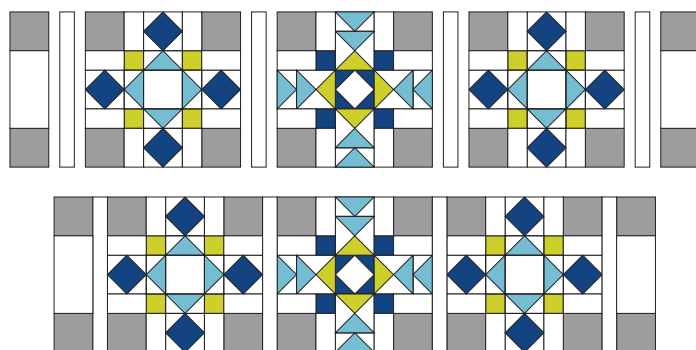
1. Arrange the following units and pieces according to the illustration.
 4 second corner units $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
 4 second doublet units $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
 1 bg square $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the pieces and units into rows, then sew the rows together, pressing the seams open or as indicated by the arrows, to make a first block $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Repeat to make a total of 5 second blocks.



Row Assembly

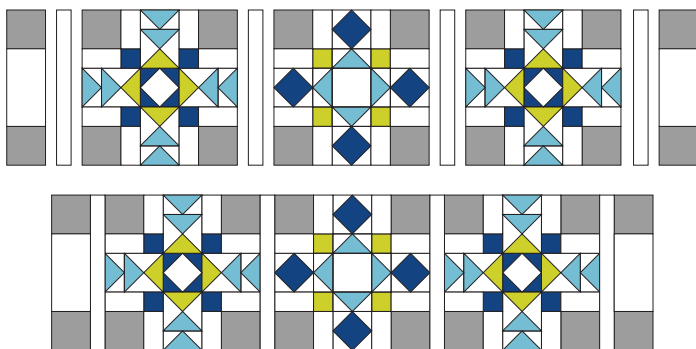
ROW A

1. Arrange the following units and pieces according to the illustration.
 1 first block $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 2 second blocks $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 2 bg/D/bg triplet units $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 4 bg rectangles $2" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the units and pieces into a row, pressing the seams open or towards the bg rectangles, to make a row A $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Repeat to make a total of 2 row A.



ROW B

1. Arrange the following units and pieces according to the illustration.
 2 first blocks $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 1 second block $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 2 bg/D/bg triplet units $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
 4 bg rectangles $2" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the units and pieces into a row, pressing the seams open or towards the bg rectangles, to make 1 row B $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$.

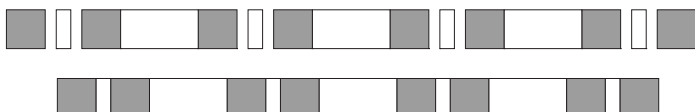


Fabric Color Key



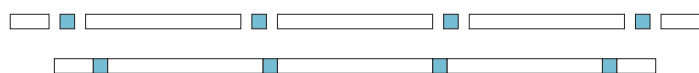
ROW C

1. Arrange the following units and pieces according to the illustration.
3 D/bg/D triplet units $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
2 fabric D squares $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$
4 bg rectangles $2" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the units and pieces, pressing the seams open or towards the bg rectangles, to make a row C $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Repeat to make a total of 2 row C.



SASHING ROW

1. Arrange the following pieces according to the illustration.
4 fabric C squares $2" \times 2"$
3 bg rectangles $2" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$
2 bg rectangles $2" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the pieces, pressing the seams open or towards the bg rectangles, to make a sashing row $2" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Repeat to make a total of 4 sashing rows.



Quilt Assembly

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange the following rows according to the quilt top assembly diagram on page 10:
2 row A $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$
1 row B $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$
2 row C $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$
4 sashing rows $2" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$
2. Sew together the rows, pressing the seams open, to make the quilt top, which will measure about $62\frac{1}{2}" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$ (before borders are added).

BORDERS

1. Sew together 2 bg strips $2" \times \text{WOF}$ and trim to the height of the quilt top, about $62\frac{1}{2}"$, to make a side border $2" \times 62\frac{1}{2}"$. Repeat to make a second side border.
2. Sew borders onto the sides of the quilt, pressing seams open or towards the borders.
3. Sew together 2 bg strips $2" \times \text{WOF}$ and trim to the width of the quilt top, about $65\frac{1}{2}"$, to make a top/bottom border $2" \times 65\frac{1}{2}"$. Repeat to make a second top/bottom border.
4. Sew borders onto the top and bottom of the quilt, pressing seams open or towards the borders.

The quilt top should measure $65\frac{1}{2}" \times 65\frac{1}{2}"$.

Finishing

Binding	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
Backing	4 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards
Batting	74" x 74"

1. Make backing: Remove selvages from backing fabric, cut into 2 pieces approx. $74" \times \text{WOF}$ and sew backing pieces together along the trimmed selvage edges using a $\frac{1}{2}"$ seam, pressing the seam open. Trim backing to approx. $74" \times 74"$.
2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste and quilt as desired.
3. Cut the binding fabric into 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$. Trim off selvages and sew together end-to-end to make the binding. Bind and enjoy your quilt!

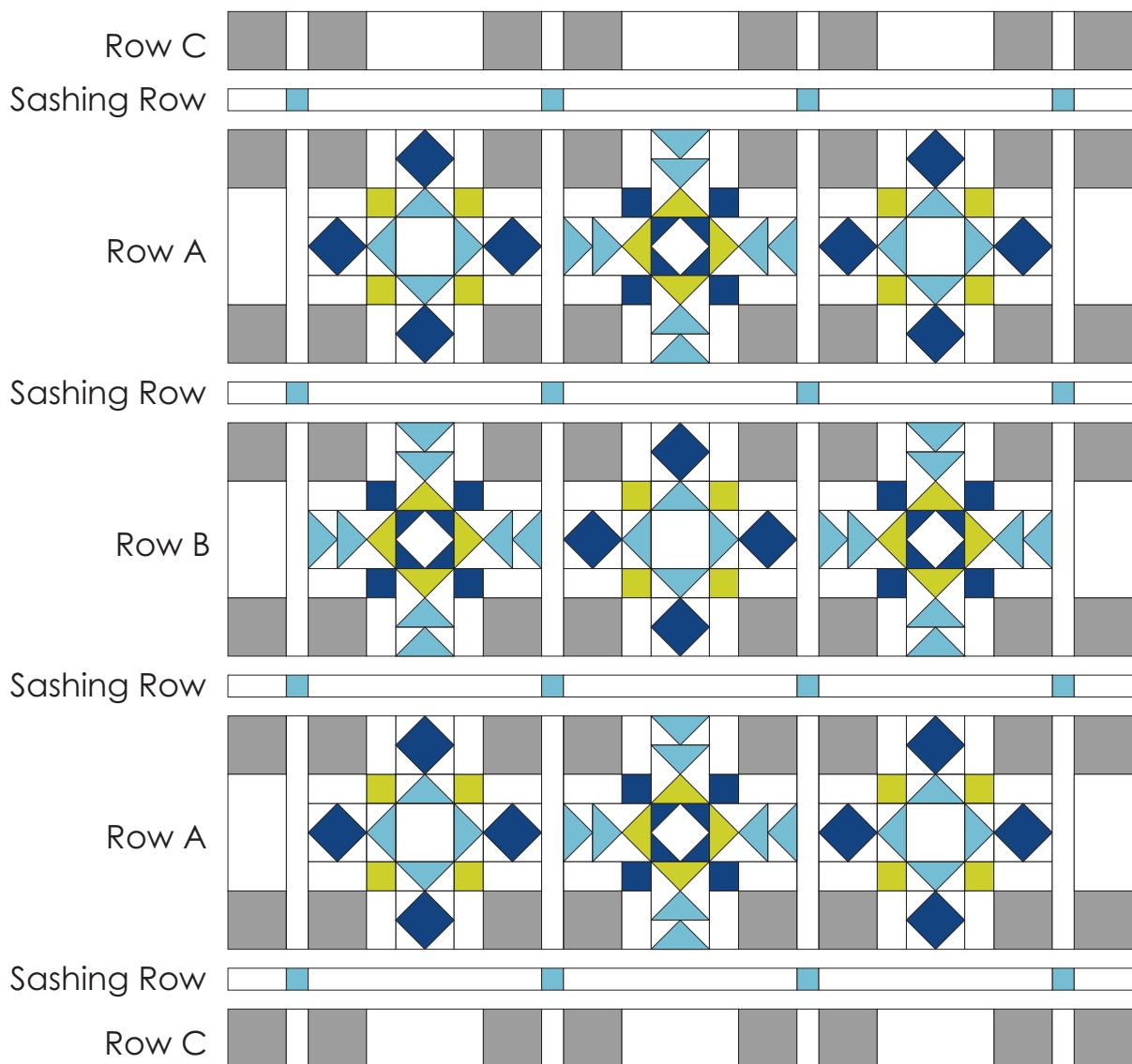
