
Doublet Units


FIRST DOUBLET UNITS

- 1. Sew together the following units, pressing the seam open or towards the hourglass unit, to make a first doublet unit 4 ½" x 6 ½".
 - 1 hourglass unit 4 ½" x 4 ½"
 - 1 flying geese 2 ½" x 4 ½"
- 2. Repeat to make a total of 16 first doublet units.




SECOND DOUBLET UNITS

- 1. Sew together the following units, pressing the seam open or towards the SiaS unit, to make a second doublet unit 4 ½" x 6 ½".
 - 1 flying geese unit 2 ½" x 4 ½"
 - 1 A/bg SiaS 4 ½" x 4 ½"
- 2. Repeat to make a total of 20 second doublet units.



FIRST CORNER UNITS

- 1. Cut each fabric A nine-patch unit in half in both horizontally and vertically in half to make 4 first corner units 6 ½" x 6 ½".
- 2. Repeat to make a total of 16 first corner units 6 ½" x 6 ½".



SECOND CORNER UNITS

- 1. Cut each fabric B nine-patch unit in half in both horizontally and vertically in half to make 4 second corner units 6 ½" x 6 ½".
- 2. Repeat to make a total of 20 second corner units 6 ½" x 6 ½".
