Welcome to the Marble Mystery Quilt

The quilt pattern is designed for an advanced beginner, there are no Y-seams, paper piecing, or appliqué in the quilt and the quilt finishes at a generous lap size of about 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

PATTERN NOTES:

- Width of fabrics (WOF) for this pattern is assumed to be 40".
- A scant 1/4" (a thread width smaller than 1/4") seam is to be used throughout the construction of the quilt unless otherwise instructed.

Fabric Requirements

| Finished Size | 65 ½" x 65 ½" |
|------------------------|---------------|
| Fabric A | ³¼ yard |
| Fabric B | ½ yard |
| Fabric C | ³¼ yard |
| Fabric D | 1 ¼ yards |
| Background (Bg) fabric | 3 ¾ yards |
| Binding Fabric | 5% yard |
| Backing Fabric | 4 1/8 yards |
| Batting | 74" x 74" |

Fabric Selection Tips

- It is suggested that a solid or a tone-on-tone print that reads as a solid be used for the background fabric.
- Due to the finished fabric piece sizes and piecing methods for the quilt top, it is recommended that fabric prints used have a non-directional design.
- Scraps or multiple fabrics can be used for any of the fabrics, but would be the most successful for Fabrics A-C. Most of the pieces for these fabrics are less than 5".
- To help plan your fabrics for the mystery quilt, be sure that all fabrics that are next to each other have enough contrast between them.

The background fabric is adjacent to Fabrics A, B, C, and D.

Except for Fabrics A and B (which touch), none of the Fabrics A-D are adjacent to each other.

Within these quilt instructions, the following colors will be used to represent the fabrics. You can use the blocks below to paste your fabrics.
