ORDINANCE 2013-7

**ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE/ UTILITY-TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE
(rev 5/14/2013)**

SECTION 1 - PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV)/Utility-Terrain Vehicle (UTV) routes and to regulate the operation of ATV's/UTV's in the town.

SECTION 2 - AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of, Oakland, Douglas County, Wisconsin, has the specific Authority to adopt this Route Ordinance under s. 23.33 (8) Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3 - ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote by a majority of the Town Board present and voting provides the authority for the Town to designate all routes in the Town and to regulate the use of those routes in the Town.

SECTION 4 - OPERATION OF ATV'S/ UTV'S

Pursuant to s. 23.33 (4) (d) 4. Wis. stats. except as otherwise provided in s. 23.33 (4), Wis. Stats., no person may operate an ATV/UTV on any portion of any roadway in the Town except on roadways that are designated as ATV/UTV routes by this ordinance.

SECTION 5 - DESIGNATION OF ROUTES

All properly signed ATV/UTV roads are designated routes in the Town.

SECTION 6 - CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES

Pursuant to s. 23.33 (8) (C) (d), Wis. stats., the following restrictions are placed on the use of ATV/UTV routes designated by this resolution:

- A. Operators must follow all applicable state and county laws.
- B. Operation shall be subject to all provisions of s. 23.33, Wis. stats. which is adopted as a part of this ordinance by reference.

C. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the Town Clerk to the Douglas County Sheriff's Department.

SECTION 7 - ENFORCEMENT

This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the Laws of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION 8- PENALTIES

The penalties under in s. 23.33 (13) (a), Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

SECTION 9 - SEVERABILITY


If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 10 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.
The Town Clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
