ORDINANCE FOR LOGGING OPERATIONS - 1996

Effective on this 1st day of October 1996, we the Town Board of Oakland, County of Douglas, resolve that all logging performed within the town of Oakland on public or private lands will be subject to the following regulations: A cash performance bond of \$500.00 will be provided to the Town of Oakland prior to any hauling. A minimum of five (5) cubic yards of 2" minus gravel will be placed at the intersection of a woods road and a surfaced (asphaltic) town road to help prevent surface break-up. This performance bond will be returned upon inspection of town roads used by the respective logger(s) by at least two (2) town board mmbers. No wood will be hauled from the site unless these requirements are met. If the people involved refuse to meet these requirements, appropriate legal action will be taken. These regulations are necessary to maintain the integrity of our town roads.
