Musch Farm Update

On Tuesday May 31 Pete Fornengo called me in the evening. He discovered a tree that had fallen on the Musch deer farm fence and had crushed it to about half its height.

Pete took a picture of the breach in the fence and agreed to report it to Douglas County on Wednesday morning. He also called Musch to let him know.

I also called Douglas County and spoke with Tessah Behlings, Planning and Zoning at 715-395-1376 (Tessah.Behlings@douglascountvwi.org). She agreed to check it out after checking the ordinance.

Pete reported on Wednesday morning that the fence had been repaired and he reported that to Tessah.

I think it is important that we report any problems with the fence to Douglas County, so that they have a record, and realize that some citizens are concerned about this issue.

The portion of the fence in question is the part running east/west along the boundary with Pete's land, about ¼ of the way west of Najt Road, along the first 40 acre parcel.
