ORDINANCE NO. 1.7

**ORDINANCE TO NAME ROADS CURRENTLY WITH MULTIPLE NAMES**

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Douglas County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 82.03 (7), Wis. statutes, to adopt this ordinance. This ordinance was adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote. A quorum was present. Proper notice having been given, establishes road names as follows:

**SECTION 1 - THE CURRENT ROCKDALE ROAD:**

The road currently known as E. Rockdale Road, which runs east from County Road K shall remain E. Rockdale Road up to approximately 1142 feet.

**SECTION 2 - THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE EAST UNNAMED SEGMENT:**

At a point approximately 1142 feet east from County K, the road segment running due east approximately 285 feet, shall now be known as E. Rockdale Road.

**SECTION 3 - THE ASSIGNMENT NORTHEAST SEGMENT OF ROCKDALE ROAD:**

At a point approximately 1142 feet east from County K, the road segment running to the northeast approximately 325 feet, shall now be known as E. Big D Road

**SECTION 4 - ROAD SIGNS**

The town chair, or his or her designee, shall erect road name signs at all intersections, as needed, to correct the names.

This ordinance is effective on posting or publishing. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
