Restoring Rice Farm Road Length to Original Footage


WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland owns the Right of Way on Rice Farm Road, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Oakland has reviewed details regarding maintenance of Rice Farm Road, the safety of our road crew and equipment, and the previous Resolution extending the road dated June 13, 2006, (see attached) and has discussed with the owners that the turnaround has become impossible to maintain and is unsafe due to debris and is recommending that the June 13, 2006, Resolution be rescinded and the road footage be returned to its original length of .6 of a mile by taking 2/10ths of a mile off the end of Rice Farm Road,


DESCRIPTION: See attached previous Resolution.




