ORDINANCE NO. 2013-7

SNOWMOBILE ROUTE ORDINANCE (rev 5/14/2013)

SECTION 1 - PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize the use of certain Town right of way's for snowmobile operation and to regulate the operation of snowmobiles in the Town.

SECTION 2 - AUTHORITY

The Town Board has the authority under s. 60.22 and 350.18, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

SECTION 3 - OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES ON TOWN PROPERTY AND HIGHWAYS.

- A. Except as provided in s. 350.02 ands. 350.045, Wis. Stats., or for snowmobile events authorized in accordance with s. 350.04, Wis. Stats., no person shall operate a snowmobile upon any public right-of-way, in any public park or on any other Town property except upon snowmobile routes designated by the Town Board.
- B. Any person legally operating a snowmobile may operate a snowmobile on or in the vicinity of a Town highway subject to the following:
 - On the right of way of a Town highway which has been designated as a snowmobile route under section 4 and which has been marked as a snowmobile route.

SECTION 4 - DESIGNATION OF TOWN SNOWMOBILE ROUTES.

- A. The following routes are designated routes in the town:
 - 1. All properly signed roads within the Town.

SECTION 5 - CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO DESIGNATED SNOWMOBILE ROUTES.

Snowmobile operation is subject to the rules and regulations of Chapter 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes and is hereby adopted by reference.

SECTION 6 - ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

- A. This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin.
- B. The penalties under s. 350.11, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

SECTION 7- SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 8 - EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The Town Clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
