Connection Groups meet every Sunday at 9:30 a.m., every Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. and also the 1st and 3rd Sunday at 6 p.m.

I love exploring the Bible! God's Word is an incredible tool that the Holy Spirit gave us so that we will be able to know God more. It is a great source of wisdom for our lives, but it takes real dedication to understand the depths of that wisdom. It is important that the church becomes competent, ethical, and virtuous readers of scripture. We offer several small groups that all focus on the importance of God's Word in our lives.

In my Sunday school class we discuss How to Study the Bible. Believe it or not, there are bad ways to use the Bible. For example, the Bible has been used to justify evils like slavery and violence. It's important for God's people to get involved in group studies about the Bible. Yes, that's right, group studies. Yes, we should be reading and studying on our own. But if that is all we do then we run the risk of spiritual drift apart from Christ's family in the church. Jesus appointed the church, collectively, to be his representatives on earth.

One way we are going to look at doing this is incorporating the Bible Engagement Project into our small groups. Bible Engagement Project exists to see every person, every home, every small group, and every local church transformed by regularly engaging with the Bible. Bible Engagement Project was created in 2017 by The General Council of the Assemblies of God through a network of visionaries—pastors and professionals, ministry leaders and small group volunteers, scriptwriters and videographers—whose goal was to see an increasingly Bibleengaged world. Because we believe a Bible-engaged church starts with a Bible-engaged pastor, we have partnered with Faithlife, makers of Logos Bible Software, to equip pastors with top-notch study resources. We want everyone who is a part of our church to get involved in this project going forward. We will be looking to find ways to make that possible with multiple opportunities to meet and learn God's Word together.
