NEW BUSINESS

Amanda Stroud and Victoria Blancato from the County explained the Permanent & Total Disability Veterans Exemption. The Town has 11 parcels that may qualify. Based on the 2025 Assessment and Town Budget it is estimated the exemption will cause a .036782 increase in property tax should the town adopt the exemption. The school needs to decide if they will adopt. There is an application process. Exemption will take effect with the 2027 tentative tax roll.

A question was asked; if the veteran passes will the exemption apply to the spouse. Answer is yes unless they remarry.
