Administrative Update

Mrs. Omensetter gave an update on changes for the new school year and upcoming events. She stated the following:

Banners/Fundraising

Jenny Kassay stated 15 banners were sold in total.

Evanitta Omensetter added the following information: as directed by new HCPS rules, Banner sales will no longer be benefiting the Booster Club and will not cover team fees. All funds will now be put into an internal school account, from which monies will be allocated to pressing needs, as needed.
