Hospitality Committee

Sales at freshman orientation were successful, about \$3200. The committee has ordered more merchandise to replenish the supply.

Concessions Committee

Coralee Traficante and Wendy Sedlacek are the concession committee chairs for this year. The concession stand is ready for the season; there is a small order left. The older Pepsi cooler is not working; a call was placed to Pepsi for a replacement. Coralee extended a big thank you to Mike Williams for all his hard work. She also thanked Mindy for providing a new microwave for the concession stand. There have been 2 cash registers placed in the concession stand, with programmed buttons for products, to ease with calculation of sales for volunteers. Coralee, Wendy and Kim Raffaele, Treasurer, will meet to discuss the bank procedures. Two times for concession stand training have been scheduled on Saturday August 11th from 10-12am or 1-3pm for open/closer volunteers (must attend 1 session, even if you have been trained in the past). The 1st game on 8/17 will be a training session for all open/closer volunteers (need at least 15) with the proceeds benefitting the Booster Club general fund.

President's Report/General Business

PDQ cards are available again this year. The cost has gone up to \$4 per card (\$3 last year). Each group/team is allowed 1000 cards, either all at once or in groups of 500.

The football team is creating a program as a fundraiser and plans to sell at games for \$5 (if county allows). Please sell advertising for the program; money and artwork is due by August 10th in order to print the program prior to the home game on August 24th.

New levels of Business Partners/Sponsorship levels will be created so that a business is only approached once and is able to write one check to the Booster Club. Banner sales, football program ads, Wall of Fame plaques, etc. will be included based on the level of sponsorship.

Senior parking spots will be sold at the same time as parking hang tags. The money raised will continue to go towards the track fund. The cost will be \$40 for seniors, \$50 for juniors and teachers. The drawing for spots (seniors 1st choice, then teachers, then juniors) and painting will take place on Saturday 8/18 (8/25 backup rain date). A design needs to be submitted for approval. Acrylic paint needs to be used.

A discussion was had to improve the wall of fame sales such as offer a smaller plaque to families, extend to students who are not on an athletic team, etc. Coach Mills will be contacted for feedback.

There are rubber wrist bands for \$5 and t-shirts for \$10 available to raise money to assist Joey Johnston, Jr. and his family. Joey Johnston, Sr. is a current board member of the Booster Club. Visit the “PrayersForJoey” Facebook page to purchase. The baseball team is sending cards to him; Coach Faedo is collecting the cards. Kim Raffaele made a motion to donate \$300 to purchase Publix and Target gift cards to assist the family. Mindy Murray seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Mrs. Omensetter asked if wrist bands and t-shirts could be available to sell at the Welcome Back breakfast for teachers. A request was made to possibly send a video of the school morning show to Joey; she will discuss with the girls basketball coach, who is sponsor for the morning show. A day to wear the t-shirts to support Joey will possibly be arranged.

Misc.

The district denied the request to pressure wash the stands at the athletic field.

The Pepsi contract with the district is coming to an end after 19 years. The football score board, which Pepsi donated the 1st year of their contract, is old and will need to be replaced eventually. The score board in the gym will be replaced and the teams that use the gym will assist with raising the funds.
