

Black Lung Ultra Checkpoints and Aid Stations –Driving Directions

Start/Finish line and Main Transition Area:

From Rocky Mountain House: Head North on Highway 11.

Follow highway 11 approx 88km to Nordegg

Turn Left onto Stuart Street (at the “Nordegg sign”)

Travel Approx 400m on Stuart Street before turning right into Nordegg Community hall

Please note on race day we will have parking just south of the hall in the large parking lot North of the Hotel. You will be able to drop racers at the hall if needed but the parking lot will be used for spectators only.

All aid stations and checkpoints follow the naming convention – first digit= leg ##, second digits = km into the leg you will encounter them.

CP104 (Leg 1 CP1) – Vehicle Access

From Rocky Mountain House

From Rocky Mountain House: Head North on Highway 11.

Follow highway 11 approx 85km, there is a large building with parking lot on your left.

From Nordegg:

Head North on Stuart Street approx 400m

Turn Right onto Highway 11 for 1.9km

Turn left into the large parking lot on your left.

CP111/116 (Leg 1 CP2)– Hike or Bike only

There are a few different ways to access this aid station, the quickest is from the Coliseum Trailhead:

From there it is a 6.6km hike with 722m elevation gain.

To access the Coliseum Trailhead:

From Nordegg Community Hall:

Head North on Stuart Street

Turn Left onto Highway 11 for 290m

Turn Right onto Shunda Creek Rd/North Subdivision West Access for 1.4km

Turn right onto Pine Martin Drive for 350m

Turn Left onto Juniper Trail for 600m

Turn Right onto Eagle Drive for 120m

Trailhead is at the end of the road.

AS211 (Leg 2 AS) 4x4 Vehicle or OHV – restricted access

This Aid Station can be accessed by ATV/OHV using the 12th level access or alternatively via the Dutch Creek road. The Dutch Creek road is owned, maintained and operated by Sundre Forest Products. There is a locked gate at the access that the race directors have the code to.

OHV Access from Nordegg Community Hall:

Head south on Stuart Street 1.1km

Turn Left onto Elizabeth Avenue for 1.1km

Travel Straight Through the T intersection where the “Road” appears to end

Travel on this road 3.7km before joining the main road.

Travel 3km until the road narrows with a large clearing on your left.

4x4 Access from Nordegg Community Hall:

Head North on Stuart Street 400m

Left onto highway 11 for 2.2km

Left onto Highway 40 (Forestry Trunk Road) for 3km

Left into Nordegg Industrial Drive for 650m

Left onto Dutch Creek Road for 11.8km until the road narrows with a large clearing on your left.

CP218 (Leg 2 CP1)- Vehicle – Gated Access

This checkpoint is behind a locked gate near Beaverdam recreational area. Race Directors have access to the gate, or the CP can be accessed via the OHV trail “Rail Trail”

From Nordegg Community Hall:

Head North on Stuart Street 400m

Turn Right onto Highway 11 for 4.5km

Turn right onto Range Road 145A for 550m (Gate!)

Turn right and follow the road into the CP.

Leg 3 Road Direction- Vehicle Access

Head North on Stuart Street 400m

Left onto highway 11 for 2.2km

Left onto Highway 40 (Forestry Trunk Road) for 2.2km

CP308 (Leg 3 CP 1)– Vehicle Access

Head North on Stuart Street 400m

Left onto highway 11 for 2.2km

Left onto Highway 40 (Forestry Trunk Road) for 3km

Left into Nordegg Industrial Drive
