

Father Jerome's Message: Baptism of the Lord

Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

When a catechumen, through OCIA, seeks Baptism and other initial Sacraments to become part of the Body of Christ – how do you understand this? The video series from FORMED called, "The Search", describes a new beginning to follow Jesus Christ following the Church teachings.

Luke's gospel explains to us every detail of Jesus' Baptism. John the Baptist's testimony - "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire", provides some of the detail. Luke mentions in the gospel that "after all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."" From here Jesus launches his public ministry preaching the good news of the Kingdom.

Every baptized person is called to preach the good news of the Kingdom. And there is no excuse! Venerable Fulton Sheen wonderfully illustrates the importance of the Rite of Baptism. "It may be objected, what good does a little water do, when poured upon the head of a child? The water in the boiler can do nothing of and by itself, nor can the water on the head of a child. But when the water in the boiler is united to the mind of an engineer, it can drive an engine across a continent or a ship across the sea. So too, when water is united to the Power of God, it can do more than change a crystal into life. It can take a creature and convert him or her into a child of God."

Thought of the Week: "With all the strength of my soul I urge you young people to approach the Communion table as often as you can. Feed on this bread of angels whence you will draw all the energy you need to fight inner battles. Because true happiness, dear friends, does not consist in the pleasures of the world or in earthly things, but in peace of conscience, which we have only if we are pure in heart and mind." 
