Father Jerome's Message: The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord Luke 2:22-40


Today's feast commemorates the day Mary and Joseph brought their firstborn son to the temple in Jerusalem to consecrate him to God. Forty days after his birth, in accordance with Mosaic Law, this visit was his very first time in the temple. It is a day of thanksgiving for Mary and Joseph in the temple for their son. There is more to contemplate than said about their visit to the temple.

The Gospel tells that two devote people recognize him in the temple. It was Simeon, guided by the Holy Spirit, who held the baby Jesus in his arms and proclaimed that in that baby boy, he had seen salvation. Anna, a prophet who spent day and night praying and fasting in the temple, immediately went out to share that the redemption of Jerusalem was at hand. Do you know that who Simeon and Anna recognized as the Savior is presented to us today in the Word and Eucharist?

Today is observed as World Day for Consecrated Life. Its purpose is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ, by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels" as well as "to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervor which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord." (St. John Paul II, 1997)

The Catholic Church celebrates World Day for Consecrated Life on the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas or the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. 
