Father Jerome's Message ... Love one another (John 13:31-33a, 34-35)

What is so new about the "new commandment?" In essence, it does not seem different from the "old." Deuteronomy 6:4 spoke of loving God with one's entire being and Leviticus 19:18 spoke of loving one's neighbor as oneself; and Jesus reaffirmed them as the "great commandment" (cf Mt 22:37-40). Yet, the "new commandment" is definitely new in terms of its model, scope, and semiotic value: we shall do this loving as Jesus has done – "Just as I have loved you, you must..." If, in the Leviticus, the "neighbor" applied tribalistically to members of one's own group, here Jesus leaves it open-ended, to include even our enemies (cf Mt 5:44; Lk 10:25-37). Thus, this love is about loving until it hurts.

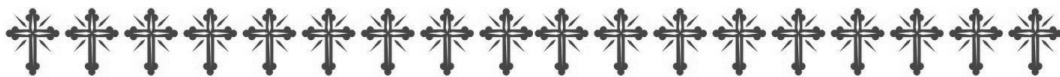
Question of the Week: How about reaching out to mend a broken relationship today, putting the new commandment to life, and helping to pitch the Kingdom in our midst?

III. The new evangelization for the transmission of the faith

The scope and limits of this Exhortation

18. I have dealt extensively with these topics, with a detail which some may find excessive. But I have done so, not with the intention of providing an exhaustive treatise but simply as a way of showing their important practical implications for the Church's mission today. All of them help give shape to a definite style of evangelization which I ask you to adopt in every activity which you undertake. In this way, we can take up, amid our daily efforts, the biblical exhortation: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say: Rejoice" (Phil 4:4).
