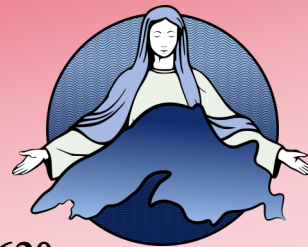

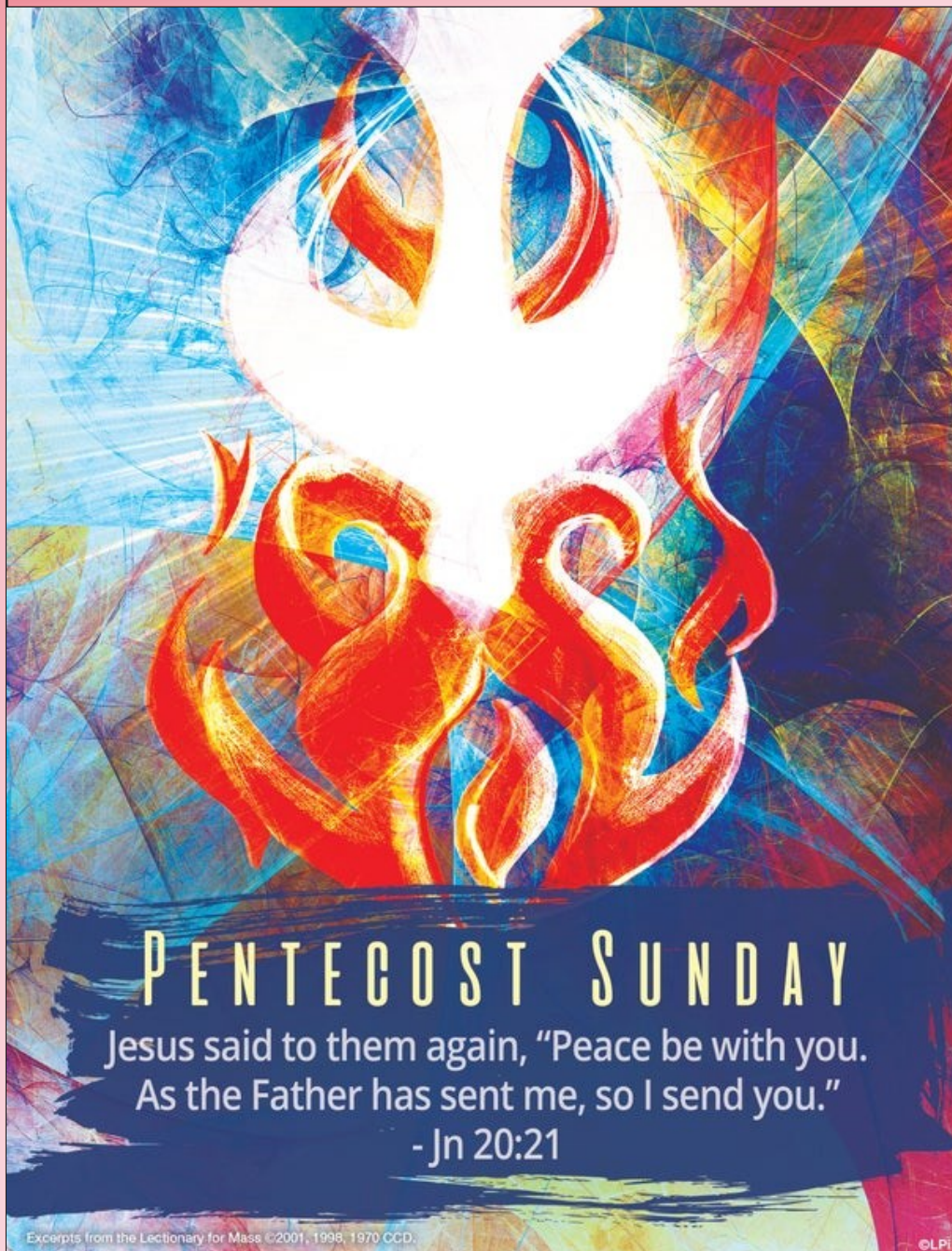

## Father Jerome's Message: Solemnity of Pentecost (John 20:19-23)

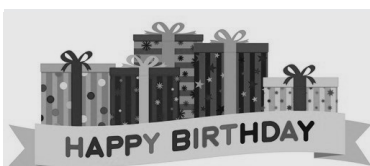


With the arrival of warmer temperatures and sunny skies, thoughts may turn to cleaning out the garage, closet, attic or other areas of your home. As you clean

## Aluminum Can Recycling

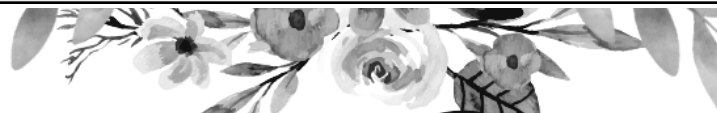
