



Do You Hear What I Hear?

Did you know, in the church tower at Our Lady of the Lake there are three bells of different sizes - large, medium and small? In the early 2000's a digital bell controller was installed that rang the bells on a specific schedule. Recently, the small bell was not ringing properly and the bells were silenced. The decision was made to upgrade the digital bell controller and replace old wiring to restore the bells to proper working order. The Verdin Company™, a nationally known maker of bells and bell ringing equipment, was hired to design a modern control system to program the bells in the tower. Dan Kupczyk, of Wire Right Electric, along with maintenance staff and several parish volunteers, worked to install the new digital controller and upgrade the necessary wiring. Once the new controller was installed, Dan Kupczyk worked with a Verdin technician to set up and program the controller.



Let the Bells Toll At 6:00 am, 12:00 pm and 6:00 pm each day the bells play the *Angelus*. The *Angelus* bell ringing is an invitation for all Christians to unite in prayer and goodwill. The *Angelus* consists of three repetitions of three strokes of the large bell with a pause, for a total of nine strokes. The nine strokes of the large bell are followed by

a three bell peal (random striking of all three bells for approximately 45 seconds). In addition, five minutes before each Mass, the bells will play a three bell peal (random stroking of all three bells for approximately 45 seconds). This is the traditional "call to worship" peal. The call to worship peal is heard Tuesday-Friday at 6:55 am, Saturdays at 5:55 pm and Sundays at 8:55 am.


