

We, the people of Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Community, believe we are called by God to live our faith and to bring others to Christ by our words and actions.



Father Jerome's Message ... Following Christ (Luke 9:51-62)

Each of us could play a role in following Christ in his/her lifetime. The disciples who were busy in preparing for a welcome in a Samaritan village failed to get support from the villagers. It might be because the disciples failed to convince the villagers to meet Jesus, who could share their life, not by how much he was going to spend in their village, but by how important it was to meet him. It was a failed attempt from the disciple's part, and they wanted to retaliate toward the villagers with anger and curse. Jesus rebuked his disciples.

It does not work, either Jesus is interested in someone or the other way. What is it then? It is something more - not just rewards, success, recognition or title, it is putting one's life behind Jesus. It is not just physically following, but it is something more – sharing your life. It is "love-less your life" and "love-more Jesus."

CHAPTER ONE: THE CHURCH'S MISSIONARY TRANSFORMATION

I. A Church which goes forth

Taking the first step, being involved and supportive, bearing fruit and rejoicing

24. The Church which "goes forth" is a community of missionary disciples who take the first step, who are involved and supportive, who bear fruit and rejoice. An evangelizing community knows that the Lord has taken the initiative, he has loved us first (cf. 1 Jn 4:19), and therefore we can move forward, boldly take the initiative, go out to others, seek those who have fallen away, stand at the crossroads and welcome the outcast. Such a community has an endless desire to show mercy, the fruit of its own experience of the power of the Father's infinite mercy. Let us try a little harder to take the first step and to become involved. Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. The Lord gets involved and he involves his own, as he kneels to wash their feet. He tells his disciples: "You will be blessed if you do this" (Jn 13:17). An evangelizing community gets involved by word and deed in people's daily lives; it bridges distances, it is willing to abase itself if necessary, and it embraces human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in others. Evangelizers thus take on the "smell of the sheep" and the sheep are willing to hear their voice. An evangelizing community is also supportive, standing by people at every step of the way, no matter how difficult or lengthy this may prove to be. ...


