Father Jerome's Message: "Where did this man get all this?" *Mark 6:1-6a*

After having enjoyed a few positive stories on strong faith, like the woman with hemorrhages and the synagogue official whose daughter was near death, Jesus healed the woman and raised the child, as we heard last week. Today's gospel gives us a lukewarm response to Jesus. The people of his native place are lost in the narratives and connections and miss the best part of Jesus. Jesus has a very good intention to bring the good news to his native place. What discouragement he meets! The citizens of his hometown saw a young man who grew up with them. They heard a number of stories and signs of Jesus. They were inquisitive to know more. It prevented them from trusting and believing in Him who grew up among them. What is happening here? Is it happening in your surroundings?

When they saw Him there was no enthusiasm or interest in seeking Him. It looks like they just missed an opportunity to listen to good news. Jesus responded to the whole situation, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house." (*Mark 6:4*) The Gospel records that Jesus did not do much in His native place. He cured a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He did not totally neglect them but showed them some concern.

Question of the Week: *How does your faith (or lack of faith) show in the way you act? How do you put your faith into action?*

- **Mass Intention Stipends:** Per the letter dated June 11th from Most Reverend James P. Powers, the new fee of \$20 for a Mass Intention will take effect this week. The change in the fee structure resulted from discussions and a decree from the bishops of the Milwaukee Ecclesial Province. The Province includes the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, the Diocese of Green Bay, Diocese of La Crosse, Diocese of Madison, and the Diocese of Superior. Essentially, all parishes in the state are effected by the new fee structure. We appreciate your understanding of the increase in fees.

Maintenance

Maintenance teams and Buildings and Grounds Committee volunteers are working this summer to take care of projects around the campus of Our Lady of the Lake Church and School. One of the first projects involved framing and closing an opening between two classrooms on the first floor of the school. In the past, pre-school students have utilized two adjacent classrooms with an opening between the rooms. Due to the large number of fifth and sixth grade students for the 2024-25 school year, the decision was made to

divide the students and form separate classrooms for grade five and grade six. The division of the two grades created the need for an additional classroom. Closing the opening between the two rooms for preschool will provide the additional classroom needed for the middle school students.

Jerry Hudak, Jeff Kupczyk, and Kevin Schmidt volunteered time to construct the wall and framing needed to enclose the opening between the classrooms. Drywall, taping, mudding and sanding was completed before the final coats of paint were added to finish the closure. Nick Urinko assisted with painting the drywall and frame, and Tom Gregoire and Dan Hovarter added the protective vinyl strip at the base of the closure.

We are grateful to these individuals for the time and talent dedicated to creating adequate learning spaces for our students.

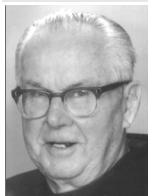
