

Father Jerome's Message ... Treasure Hunt (Luke 12:32-48)

All the three readings of the day deal with the theme of faith: trusting the promises of God and being on the alert for its fulfillment. Jesus observes: "where your treasure is, there will your heart be also." Abraham and other patriarchs lived their lives treasuring God's promises. What we treasure will orient our entire being and guide our lives. Think of a mother who is deep asleep, totally oblivious to the noise of the traffic on the nearby road or the planes that fly above; yet the slightest whimper of her new-born baby will wake her up. For she treasures her baby. Your life is around your treasure, and you use all your energy to protect it.

Where is the place of God in your life? If God is your treasure, then your life will be around Him. You make all efforts to reach out to Him and keep connected at all times. What creates extraordinary holiness in the lives of saints is their treasuring God and His Will.

But it will prove beneficial for them not to lose contact with the rich reality of the local parish and to participate readily in the overall pastoral activity of the particular Church.[29] This kind of integration will prevent them from concentrating only on part of the Gospel or the Church or becoming nomads without roots.
